### Program Objectives

To provide a practical overview and seasonally relevant hands-on experience on a working specialty cut flower farm. Our objective will be to provide an introduction to the philosophy and adaptive problem solving skills needed to run a successful and sustainable small-scale diversified operation. Intern will be given opportunities to learn seasonally relevant production techniques and also gain an understanding of marketing challenges and solutions unique to the cut flower industry.

### Expectations of Intern

- To provide a standard 40 hours of curriculum activities per week. Specific activities will be determined by weather and season.
- To be present on the job and bring your best self
- To be safe when you are working.
- To learn as much as you can.

### Expectations of Farm

- To provide room and board plus a \$200 per week stipend.
- To explain things while we are engaged in activities so learning objectives can be achieved.
- To make an effort to provide as wide a range of curriculum activities as weather and season allow.
- To provide a safe learning environment.
